## **RULES**

## **Duration of contest**

The "GagneTaBourse.ca" Contest (hereinafter "the Contest") is organized by Caisse Desjardins de Vaudreuil-Soulanges (hereinafter "the Organizer"). The registration period runs from midnight on Monday October 18, 2021, to 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday November 30, 2021. Winners will be announced on Saturday, January 22, 2022.

## Eligibility

The Contest is open to full members of Caisse Desjardins de Vaudreuil-Soulanges as of October 18, 2021, who are also:

Full-time, post-secondary students (vocational, college or university) in the fall of 2021 or winter of 2022, in one of the educational institutions recognized by the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (hereinafter "eligible Participants").

## **Exclusions**

Not eligible for the Contest:

Students who received a Caisse Desjardins de Vaudreuil-Soulanges student grant the previous year (2020-2021 contest), unless they have changed their level of education since then.

## **HOW TO ENTER**

To enter the "GagneTaBourse.ca" Contest without purchase or obligation, eligible students must complete the entry form available on the Caisse Desjardins de Vaudreuil-Soulanges website at

There is a limit of one (1) entry per eligible Participant, regardless of registration method.

No purchase or fee required.

#### **PRIZES**

The total value of the student grants awarded is \$60,000 divided into 50 grants and allocated as follows:

Vocational training and college programs	4 grants of \$500 12 grants of \$750 5 grants of \$1,000 2 grants of \$1,250

Grants will be awarded in Canadian funds, by direct deposit at the discretion of the Organizer.

#### **DRAW**

The winners will be determined by random manual draw from among the eligible entries received. The draw will take place on Tuesday, December 7, at 3 p.m., before witnesses, at the Organizer's offices, at the Caisse Desjardins de Vaudreuil-Soulanges Service Centre, 455 Saint-Charles Avenue, Vaudreuil-Dorion.

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received between October 18 and November 30, 2021, inclusive.

#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- **1. In order to be declared a winner,** a selected Participant will be required to:
  - a. Be reachable by telephone or email within fifteen (15) days of the draw. The Contest Organizer will make a maximum of two (2) attempts to reach the selected Participant, who in turn will have 72 hours to contact the Organizer following the message via voice mail or email, if applicable, left by the Organizer, failing which the Participant will forfeit their right to the prize. In the case of a minor Participant, the Organizer or its representatives will contact the selected Participant's parent or legal guardian by telephone or email no later than fifteen (15) days following the draw. The parent or legal guardian must respond to the Organizer's message within 48 hours, failing which the selected Participant will forfeit their right to the prize. The prize will then be awarded to the next Participant, whose name has been drawn, and the same procedure will be followed until a winner is selected.

- Prizes will be presented in an awards ceremony, scheduled for Saturday, January 22, 2022, and will be paid by direct deposit once the Participant or their guardian has given their consent.
- b. Confirm that they meet eligibility and other requirements under the rules. Proof of residence and photo ID, as well as proof of enrollment in an educational institution for the fall 2021 or winter 2022 semesters, will be required. The following documents are accepted as proof of identity: birth certificate, Quebec health insurance card, bus pass, Canadian citizenship card, permanent resident card, student card, passport, driver's license.
- Correctly answer, without assistance and in a limited time, the mathematical skills test question on the entry form.
- d. Winners must complete and sign the Declaration and Liability Release form (hereinafter, the "Declaration form") sent by the Organizer no later than December 14, 2021.

A parent or legal guardian must sign the form if the selected participant is a minor.

Failure to comply with any of the above conditions or any other condition contained in the rules will result in the selected Participant being disqualified and, at the Organizer's discretion, a new draw for the prize will be conducted in accordance with the rules, until a Participant is declared a prize winner. The same terms and conditions will continue to apply, with adjustments if necessary.

If a selected Participant declines their prize, the Organizer will be released from any obligation with respect to awarding this prize and may, at its discretion, cancel the prize or hold a new draw in the manner described in the preceding paragraph.

- 2. Transfer of prizes. The winners and grants will be announced at an online event presented on January 22, 2022, from 11 a.m. to noon. The Organizer will send an official confirmation of the deposit into the winner's account by e-mail. If the winner is a minor residing in Quebec, the prize may only be claimed by the person entered in the Contest with the written consent of one of their parents or guardian, who will confirm the Participant's age; and only if the Participant satisfies all of the Contest terms and conditions and signs the Declaration Form releasing the Organizer and persons for whose benefit the Contest is held from all liability for any damage or loss resulting from participation in the Contest, or the award or use of the prize, or its quality, or any defect in the prize or its loss in transit.
- 3. Verification. All entry forms and Declaration Forms are subject to verification by the Organizer. Forms that are incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, mechanically reproduced, mutilated, fraudulent, filed or transmitted late, or that have an invalid telephone number, or that are otherwise non-compliant, may be rejected and will not be eligible for a prize.
- 4. Disqualification. Any person participating in the Contest or attempting to do so by any means contrary to the Contest rules or unfair to other Participants (e.g., computer hacking, use of a voting group, use of an impersonator) will be automatically disqualified and the competent legal authorities may be notified.
- 5. Conduct of the Contest. Any attempt to sabotage the Contest process constitutes a violation of civil and criminal laws. Should such an attempt be made, the Organizer reserves the right to reject the entry of the Participant concerned and to seek remedies under the law.
- 6. Acceptance of prizes. Prizes must be accepted as described in the rules and may not be exchanged, substituted or transferred to another person, except as provided for in the rules.
- 7. Limitation of liability. If the Organizer cannot award the prize as described in the rules, it reserves the right to award a prize of the same kind and equivalent value. In the event that the number of eligible Participants is less than the number of prizes offered, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel the excess prizes.
- 8. Limitation of liability. Use of prizes. The winner releases the Organizer and persons for whose benefit the Contest is held from any liability for damages that may result from their participation in the Contest and their acceptance and use of the prize. The winner acknowledges that upon receipt of the prize or the letter confirming the prize, the performance of obligations related to the prize becomes the sole and exclusive responsibility of the various suppliers of products and services. The winner agrees to sign a declaration and release form to this effect.

- 9. Limitation of liability. Contest operation. The Organizer and persons for whose benefit the Contest is held disclaim all liability for the malfunctioning of any computer component, software or communication line, for the loss or lack of network communication, or for any transmission that is faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible or deleted by any computer or network, which may limit or prevent the possibility of reading the Contest rules. They also disclaim all liability for any damage or loss that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by the downloading of any web page, software or other material, or by the transmission of any information related to participation in the Contest. In particular, if the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest is corrupted or adversely affected by, among others, viruses, bugs, tampering, unauthorized interventions, fraud and computer technical failures, the Organizer reserves the right, without prior notice, to modify, extend, suspend or cancel the Contest.
- 10. Limitation of liability. Facebook. Participants acknowledge that the Facebook site is not the property of the Organizer and is not operated by the Organizer and further acknowledge that they are subject to Facebook's conditions of use. Personal information collected in the context of the Contest is for the exclusive use of the Organizer and will not be communicated in any way to Facebook. Facebook is not associated with the Contest and does not sponsor it in any way. No liability can be attributed to it in this respect.
- 11. Limitation of liability. Receipt of entries. The Organizer and the persons for whose benefit the Contest is held will not be held responsible for lost, misdirected or late entries, including those due to postal issues, or any other failure, for any reason whatsoever of the website during the Contest period, including any damage to a Participant's computer or mobile device.
- 12. Limitation of liability. Circumstances beyond the Organizer's control. The Organizer and the persons for whose benefit the Contest is held will not assume any liability whatsoever in the event that their inability to act results from a fact or situation beyond their control, or a strike, lockout or any other labour dispute within the organizations or companies whose services are used for holding the Contest.
- 13. Modification of the Contest. The Organizer reserves the right and has sole discretion to modify in whole or in part, suspend, cancel or terminate the Contest if an event or any human situation should arise that could influence the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the Contest as provided for in the Contest rules. No liability may be attributed (subject to the approval of the Régie in Quebec).
- 14. End of participation in the Contest. In the event that, for any reason whatsoever, participation in the Contest must end in whole or in part before the closing date provided for in the Contest rules, the prize may be awarded, at the Organizer's discretion, from among the entries duly received and recorded up to the date of the event that ended participation in the Contest.

- 15. Limitation of liability. Participation in the Contest. By participating or attempting to participate in the Contest, every entrant releases the Organizer and persons for whose benefit the Contest is held from any liability for any damage they may suffer as a result of their participation or attempt to participate in the Contest. In all cases, the Organizer shall not be required to award more prizes or award a prize other than in accordance with the Contest rules.
- 16. Prize acceptance. Every winner authorizes the Organizer and persons for whose benefit the Contest is held to use, if necessary, their name, photograph, image, voice, place of residence and declaration relating to the prize for publicity purposes, without any form of compensation.
- 17. Communication with Participants. No communication or correspondence will be exchanged with Participants in connection with the Contest other than in accordance with the Contest rules, or at the Organizer's initiative, or to obtain their consent to use their entry text without purchase or compensation.
- 18. Personal information. Personal information collected about Participants will only be used for the purposes of managing the Contest. No communication, commercial or otherwise, unrelated to the Contest will be sent to the Participant, unless otherwise consented to.
- 19. Ownership. Entry forms and Declaration forms are the property of the Contest Organizer and will not be returned to Participants under any circumstances.
- 20. Decisions. By entering the Contest, entrants agree to abide by the Contest rules and the final and binding decisions of the Contest Organizer managing the Contest. Any dispute respecting the organization or conduct of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any dispute respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of attempting to settle it.
- 21. If any paragraph of these rules is declared by a competent court to be deemed illegal, unenforceable or void, then that paragraph will be considered null and void, but all other paragraphs that are not affected will be applied to the extent permitted by law.
